Partner/junior memberships linked to an existing OBA Community or OBA Full Member are \$10 per person per year. These family accounts give all family members access to court rates at the primary member rate but only include one affiliation, please see FAQs for more details.

Everyone who creates a profile in our Hello Club system but does not select the Community or Full Membership will automatically be a Casual Member.

All OBC users should have their own Hello Club profile, and you should not share your profile password with others since it is linked to your financial details/balance.

What are the benefits of being a Full Member?

- Entry into Badminton New Zealand sanctioned events throughout NZ, including in Otago.
- The cheapest court hire rates of the three membership types.
- The ability to book multiple courts at once.
- Cheaper entry fees into some OBC events/sessions.

How do I book courts at the OBC?

- You must first create a Hello Club profile https://booking.badmintonotago.org.nz/login. You can then add money to your profile and book courts as a Casual, Community member, or a Full Member, depending on your membership status.
- You can use the Hello Club interface either via the website (https://booking.badmintonotago.org.nz/login) or using the touchscreen kiosk inside the OBC (log into Hello Club kiosk by using your Tag or by entering your PIN).

How can I add money to my account?

- Via the Hello Club interface payments can be either credit/debit card (internally through stripe as a payment gateway) or via an account to account payment via POLi.
- Credit/Debit is 3.25% + 50c per transaction (so if you are adding \$100 to your account you will be charged \$103.75 by the system)
- Poli is 1%+GST with a max of \$1(excl GST) (so if you are adding \$100 to your account you will be charged \$101.15 by the system).

How do I access the OBC?

• Enter your personal PIN (which you should not share with others) into the keypad at the OBC door. Your PIN is listed in your 'Profile' section on the Hello club website when you are logged in.

• Hold your membership Tag up to the Tag reader at the OBC door.

Once I have signed up as an OBC Community Member or OBC Full Member, how do I get my OBC Access Tag?

• Please email suematt@xtra.co.nz to organise a time to collect your Tag from the OBC. Remember – you don't need a Tag to get in, you can enter your own personal PIN (even as a Casual Member) at the keypad.

I've lost my OBC Access Tag, what should I do?

• Please let the OBA know immediately, so we can cancel your lost tag. If you want a replacement OBC Access Tag, this can be purchased for \$20.

Will the door to the OBC be unlocked or open if I have a booking?

• For private bookings the front door will remain locked and closed and you need to enter your **personal PIN** on the front door PIN pad to get in. For others in your



- playing group that have not made the booking but have a profile in the Hello Club system they can enter their own personalised PIN to gain access. If members of your playing group do not have Hello Club profiles hence their own PIN, then other members of the playing party will need to let them into the OBC.
- For security reasons, please do not wedge the entry door open/leave it open, unless authorised by the OBC/OBA.
- All casual, community and Full members are assigned a personal PIN, so encourage all players in your party to sign up and have their own PIN for ease of entry.
- The front door will remain unlocked (but closed) even when the door is shut for the duration of an Event booking or club night-type Event booking. Note Event bookings are made by OBC management and cannot be made by individual members.

Will the lights automatically come on at my booked time?

• Yes, the lights for your booked court will turn on automatically. There is a 15 second turn off between bookings of different people on the same court to signal the end of a booking and start of a new booking.

I need to cancel a booking, is the court hire refunded?

• If you cancel your booking earlier than 2 hours before your booking - you will be refunded. Once within 2 hours of your booking, the court hire will be charged.

How do I set up partner/family linked memberships?

- If you are a Community Member or Full Member, family members can sign up with their own profile and link it to your membership at sign up, and will then be charged the \$10 family member linked membership fee. The primary member must already be created in the system, then family members link to this profile as they sign up/join. A 'Partner' is a household partner, and a Junior is defined as a household member under 19 years of age.
 - Linked family memberships do not automatically share the same account balance, if you want to do this you need to set up a family Circle, see below.

If I am a Full member and link family members are they also affiliated to OBA?

• No – there is only one affiliation to OBA per purchased Full membership. If several people in your Family want to play in BNZ sanctioned tournaments then you will need to affiliate each separately. Please contact sectretary@badmintonotago.org.nz for details on how to arrange and pay an additional charge for this.

What is a circle and how can I set one up?

• Circles are a feature of the Hello Club system and are a way for members to group themselves together. Once established, the circle lead can take financial responsibility over the other profile account, and can make booking for circle members.
